
Welcome to The OVAL We're so happy to have you here.



Nestled in the South Mountain Reservation near Maplewood, NJ, The OVAL is the perfect spot for a troop picnic, bridging ceremony, evening campfire or a day/overnight of camping fun. Our rustic cabins are a great first-time camp experience; more advanced campers can pitch their own tents in the woods or on the lawn. Use The OVAL as your base camp as you explore miles of hiking trails in the adjacent South Mountain Reservation or stay on site to enjoy classic camp activities like archery, arts & crafts, and more! The OVAL is removed from the hustle and bustle of metro New Jersey so you can unplug, tune in and get outside without going too far off the grid. We are here to make your stay easy, enjoyable and fun! While camping at The OVAL is primarily seasonal, as our cabins are not winterized, check with the Camp to see year-round availability!

This packet includes important information about fees, basic policies, and a reservation form. Please carefully read all of the documents, fill out the Reservation Form, and return it with the required \$100 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit. Reservations will be entered in our schedule only when a deposit and the proper paperwork are received.

- All cancellations and site releases must be received in writing twelve weeks prior to your reservation date or you will be responsible for full payment of sites originally scheduled.
- Final payment for cabins/tent units is due four weeks prior to your arrival. Payment for addons is due the week after your trip.
- All paperwork and necessary certifications are due two weeks prior to your arrival.
- Any GSHNJ troops or service units must complete and submit a Troop Trip Application and Roster Template thirty days prior to your event to info@gshnj.org.



Please note, it is likely that you will be sharing The OVAL with others and careful scheduling is necessary to accommodate the needs of everyone on site.

Overnight Camping Event	Available Mid- April to Mid-October. Select your accommodations, plan your own activities or pick from ours, and select other venues around camp to explore. Want to camp after October or before April? Check with the Camp Team at rentals@gshnj.org.	See below for individual site rates
Day Trip	Available year round, weather permitting. Use of the camp from 9 am - 6 pm. A covered shelter can be provided for your use, based on availability. Activities are charged based on outlined fees.	\$5 per person per day
Evening Campfire	Available year round, weather permitting. A great way to gather your troop, group, or Service Unit! Come to The OVAL and gather around the main campfire circle in the field area. S'mores supplies, firewood and fire starters provided. Lead the activity yourself or add on a SME at the fees listed below. Campfire time period is a maximum of 2 hours.	\$6 per person per campfire
OVAL Field Fire Circle Picnic Grove	The central area of camp is shared by everyone. The OVAL has open space for outdoor activities, a flag pole, and parking. There is one large fire circle with benches that comfortably accommodate up to 30 people, with ample space for more seating. Double-sided stone grills on the field are perfect for outdoor cooking. The Picnic Grove has tables for general use.	Cost dependent on chosen activities and based on availability.

Cabin Amenities	Cabins have a large main room, with stone fireplace(not usable at this time), screened porch, kitchen, and bathroom. Cabins have running cold water (seasonally), flush toilets, and electricity. Cabins are seasonal and do not have heat. Kitchens are equipped with a propane-powered stove, refrigerator, sink with running cold water, and basic cooking equipment. The large main rooms can be used for activities or sleeping and have tables & benches. Screened porches can be used as sleeping areas. There are two cots and mattresses in each cabin; all others sleep on the floor.	See bel individual c	
Deer Lodge Capacity 20-25	Deer has all the standard cabin accommodations, plus two shower stalls with hot water, recently renovated bathrooms, and a small designated parking area next to the cabin.
