Connect

Now it's time to take what you've learned and put it to use! To complete this step, work with a grown-up in your household to build a sun safety bag.

Think about what you will need to keep you and your family safe when you go to the park, the beach, the woods, or anywhere outside? Gather those items and place them in a bag so you're always ready to go.

Place your sun safety bag somewhere that will help you to remember to bring it with you!

Take Action

Last but not least, it's time to take action in your community. Think about how you can share what you've learned to make a difference.

Here are some ideas suggested by your fellow Girl Scouts:

- Create a sun safety poster and find a high traffic place to post it in your community.
- Make more than one sun safety bag and donate it.
- Design a post or series of posts for social media sharing what you've learned.
- Prepare a lesson on sun safety for younger Girl Scouts and teach it to a troop in your community.

You may think of something else that's not on this list! The goal is to make a change in your community.
