Duties include sweeping and mopping floors and porches, cleaning sinks, showers, toilets, countertops, and tables. • Assist in the kitchen with the washing of pots and pans and sweeping and mopping daily. • Assist on Change Days with the transportation of luggage and in parking cars. (RESIDENT CAMP ONLY) • Assist at all camp cookouts. • Ensure any equipment used is put back clean and in ready to use condition. • Perform routine security checks to ensure camp property, buildings, and grounds are safe and secure. Report any security issues to the Camp Director. • Reports any hazards or broken equipment to the Head Cook/Camp Director. • Attends staff training and meetings as scheduled. • Perform other duties as assigned for the betterment of the campers, program, camp, and the council.
