

## Camp Hoover.... You've Registered and Now What?

### What Now??

- Review the materials on-line regarding Camp Hoover
  - Upload all information into the CAMPWISE system related to the Health History, Medication, Camper Information, etc
  - Confirm that your camper has a valid 2023 Girl Scout Membership.
    - If your camper is not registered – Follow the instructions in our FAQ [Girl Scout Membership Information](#) on page 19 in the Camp Guide.
  - Final Payment is due June 11, 2023
- Complete all forms
  - [Change In Camper Pick Up/Drop off Form](#) – complete if changes in Pick Up/Drop Off (dates and times)
  - [Change in Adult Picking Up](#) – complete if your camper is being picked up by another parent/adult who is not listed in CAMPWISE account
  - Specialty program permission slips (will be emailed to participants) for the necessary programs by June 30<sup>th</sup> – if no forms are emailed then none are needed.
- Complete all the necessary forms and bring with you when dropping your camper off at camp or email to [dhooker@gshnj.org](mailto:dhooker@gshnj.org).

### Week Leading up to Camp...

- Begin to monitor your camper's health
  - Campers who are sick or they have recently had a close contact with someone who is ill are required to quarantine/stay home as advised by a medical professional or as outlined by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. We ask that you please inform us if your child is ill and will no longer be able to attend their session as soon as you can. We will work with you to move them to another session and program or refund your fees per our policy.
- We ask that families engage in healthy hygiene practices and follow guidance from all governing bodies when it comes to minimizing exposure to communicable diseases.
- Discuss with your camper if they would like to mask at any point during their time at camp and what those situations will look like – ie. in the dining hall, at the campfire, etc.
- Reach out with any last minute questions – please give us at least 48 hours to respond – [dhooker@gshnj.org](mailto:dhooker@gshnj.org) or 973-383-3220.
- Review with your camper that we are a tech free camp and that they will be receiving mail from you when they are away.
- Practice writing a letter and addressing envelopes or send self addressed and stamped envelopes with your camper.

## 4 – 5 Days Before Camp...

- Write your camper a letter or a postcard or two – if multiple letters include what day to delivery on the bottom left corner so we can distribute throughout the week.

- When sending your camper a care package – please do not include any food or snack items. Care packages with food will not be delivered to your camper.
- Review the Confirmation Materials – found in the dashboard in CAMPWISE and Rallyhood
- Check the Packing List carefully

## Day of Arrival...

- Eat lunch before arriving at camp
- Campers should have a day backpack that they will carry with them along with a water bottle. Be sure to label these with your camper's first and last name. A small hand sanitizer and a small package of disinfectant wipes should be available in the backpack as well.
- Have labeled medicines in original containers with name and directions in a zip-lock bag.
- Additional Trading Post Money if needed – only cash and check will be accepted
- Arrive at camp between 2:00 and 3:00 pm on Sunday
  - \* *A Little Camp Fun* – arrive at camp between 9:00 and 10:00 am on Thursday

## Pick up...

- Pick up between 9:00 and 10:00 am on Saturday
- *Mini Camp* – pick up between 3:30 and 4:30 pm on Wednesday
