- Any Girl Scout troops or service units must complete and submit a <u>Trip Application</u> and <u>roster</u> thirty days prior to your event to info@gshnj.org.
- Prior to arrival, all members of your group will need to verify that they are not presenting any symptoms of illness/communicable disease or recently interacted with anyone who has been ill or had a communicable disease or are fully vaccinated.
