We're so happy to have you here.

Nestled in the South Mountain Reservation near Maplewood, NJ, The OVAL is the perfect spot for a troop picnic, bridging ceremony, evening campfire or a day/overnight of camping fun. Our newly updated rustic cabins are a great first-time camp experience or more advanced campers can pitch their own tents in the woods or the lawn. Use The OVAL as your base camp as you explore miles of hiking trails in the adjacent reservation or stay on site to enjoy classic camp activities like archery, arts & crafts, and more! The OVAL is removed from the hustle and bustle of metro New Jersey so you can unplug, tune in and get outside without going too far off the grid. We are here to make your stay easy, enjoyable and fun!

This packet includes important information about fees, basic policies, and a reservation form. Please carefully read all of the documents, fill out the Reservation Form, and return it with the required \$100 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit. Reservations will be entered in our schedule only when a deposit and the proper paperwork are received.

- All cancellations and site releases must be received in writing **twelve weeks** prior to your reservation date or you will be responsible for full payment of sites originally scheduled.
- Final payment is due **four weeks** prior to your arrival.
- All paperwork and necessary certifications are due **two weeks** prior to your arrival.
- Any Girl Scout troops or service units must complete and submit a [Trip Application](#) and [roster](#) **thirty days** prior to your event to info@gshnj.org
- Prior to arrival, all members of your group will need to verify that they are not presenting any symptoms of illness/communicable disease or recently interacted with anyone who has been ill or had a communicable disease or are fully vaccinated.



Please note, it is likely that you will be sharing The OVAL with others and careful scheduling is necessary to accommodate the needs of everyone on site. When sharing the facility, contact information will be shared with all parties.

Overnight Camping Event	Available Mid- April to Mid-October. Select your accommodations, plan your own activities or pick from ours, and select other venues around camp to explore.	See below for individual site rates

Cabin Amenities	Cabins have a large main room, with stone fireplace(not usable at this time), screened porch, updated kitchen, and bathroom. Cabins have running cold water, flushing toilets, and electricity with outlets. Cabins are seasonal and do not have heat. Kitchens are equipped with a propane-powered stove, refrigerator, sink with running cold water, and basic cooking equipment. The large main rooms can be used for activities or sleeping, tables, benches, and chairs. There are two cots and mattresses in each cabin; all others sleep on the floor. Reservation fees: Total fees of \$100 or less must be paid in full at the time of the reservation. If the fees total more than \$100, a deposit of \$100 is due at the time of the reservation in order to hold the site. The remainder of the rental fee is due four weeks prior to arrival. If the date you requested is available, a rental invoice with billing and additional information will be issued. If the date is not available, you will be notified. If no date works for your group, then the deposit will be refunded. All Non-GSHNJ rental groups will need to provide a Certificate of Insurance naming GSHNJ as the insured for dates of the trip.

Canceling a portion or entire reservation: All cancellations must be received in writing 12 or more weeks prior to your arrival date. If you cancel by this time, you will receive a refund minus the non-refundable, non-transferrable deposit. No refund will be issued if fewer than 12 weeks' notice is given. If the site is closed by GSHNJ due to weather or maintenance problems, a credit for a future rental or a full refund will be issued.
