
Welcome to Camp DeWitt! We're so happy to have you here.



Located on nearly 150 acres in Hillsborough, New Jersey, there is something for everyone at Camp DeWitt! From pitching a tent of your own in our fields, to using our own seasonal platform tents to our heated (or air conditioned!) DeWitt Cabin, you'll find accommodations for even the newest campers. Each of our sites has access to nearby latrines and water and our cabin has a fully stocked kitchen for your use. Our fields have covered pavilions to offer shade and shelter from the heat and the rain. Groups are invited to plan your own adventures or arrange for individual program activities for your event, from archery to our low ropes challenge course to make and take crafts! We are here to make your stay easy, enjoyable, and fun!

This packet includes important information about fees, basic policies, and a reservation form. Please carefully read all of the documents, fill out the Reservation Form, and return it with the required \$100 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit. Reservations will be entered in our schedule only when a deposit and the proper paperwork are received.

- All cancellations and site releases must be received in writing twelve weeks prior to your reservation date, or you will be responsible for full payment of sites originally scheduled.
- Final payment for cabins/tent units is due **4 weeks** prior to your arrival. Payment for addons is due the week after your trip.
- All paperwork and necessary certifications are due **two weeks** prior to your arrival.
- Any GSHNJ troops or service units must complete and submit a <u>Troop</u> <u>Trip Application</u> and <u>Roster Template</u> thirty days prior to your event to info@gshnj.org.
- If submitted after **30 days** your trip may not be approved, your event may be cancelled, and you will still be responsible for payment of full fees.



Please note, it is likely that you will be sharing Camp DeWitt with others and careful scheduling is necessary to accommodate the needs of everyone on site. When sharing the facility, contact information will be shared with all parties.
